Center Support Bulletin

Selling center support bearings used to be a lot easier when you could sell by bearing size alone. As drivelines have changed and mounting brackets have changed, there are many more frame configurations that you need to be aware of when selling center supports. Using the part numbers below as an example, while all have the same bearing inside diameter (I.D.) all also have different bearing center lines and frames.

While this is only one example of the same bearing dimension and different brackets, it holds true for all center support bearings on import and domestic drivelines.

When selling center supports, always pay particular attention to the catalog application as driveshaft and driveline configurations have changed substantially over the years.

Getting the Customer the right part based on the application will reduce returns and increase sales.
